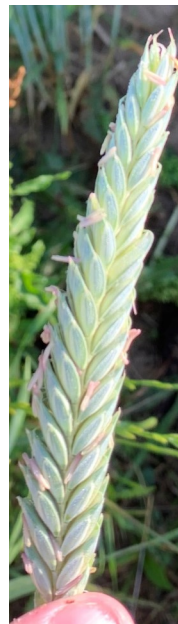




# SURGE TRITICALE

This high sugar variety is facultative, meaning that it does not need to go through a cold period to be productive. Thinner bladed than what you may see from 815i, but with a longer window of production.

- Dual planting window, spring/fall
- Awnless (beardless)
- Late maturity
- High seed yield
- High silage yield
- Good silage quality
- Widely adapted throughout the US, spring planted across the northern US or fall planted in CA and the southern US

## Planting Instructions

- Drill at 0.5-0.75" depth. Calibrate your drill to ensure an accurate rate. Broadcasting without incorporation is not recommended due to seed size.

## Establishment

- **Seeding rate- Cover Crop**  
50-100lbs/A
- **Seeding rate- Grazed**  
100-150lbs/A
- **Planting Depth**  
0.5-0.75"
- **Target Harvest Height**  
8-15" for grazing
- **Target Residual Height For Regrowth-**  
2.5-3"
